

Rockin' Ram Award

The Rockin' Ram Award is a difficult, but achievable award given at the end of the year. There are specific goals that students work to achieve throughout the school year. Students must complete 16 out of 20 academic and/or personal goals. This award is for the students that want to go the distance. *It's the student's responsibility to keep track of their goals and make sure that items are checked off.*

Requirements:

1. Maintain at least an 85% average on Spelling tests for one term.
2. Maintain at least an 85% average on Vocabulary tests for one term.
3. Turn in 100% of assignments and homework for one term.
4. Create a survey, analyze it, and show the results on a graph.
5. Pass off multiplication timed tests through 12s by the end of the year.
6. Pass off division timed tests through 12s by the end of the year.
7. Participate in *Reflections*.
8. Memorize and label all of Utah's 29 counties on a map.
9. Complete an at home science project related to a unit of study in class. Keep close records of your experiment!
10. Do a Rock Cycle Project.
11. Meet the monthly independent reading goal for 8 months.
12. Help in the lunchroom 5 times without being assigned. (Get signatures from the janitors, lunch-ladies, or lunchroom aides.)
13. Publish a short narrative, opinion paper, or research paper on your own.
14. Run one mile in 10 minutes or less.
15. Be able to type 20 wpm on 3 consecutive timings with 3 or less mistakes.
16. Give a 5-10 minute anti-bullying presentation to the class. (Can be done with a partner.)
17. Participate in an extra-curricular activity (sports, scouts, dance, music, etc.).
18. Give 5 hours of service to a worthwhile project.
19. Participate in the school chorus for the Christmas Concert and/or the Spring Concert.
20. Create your own goal and track your progress. (*Must be cleared by Miss Church first.*)
