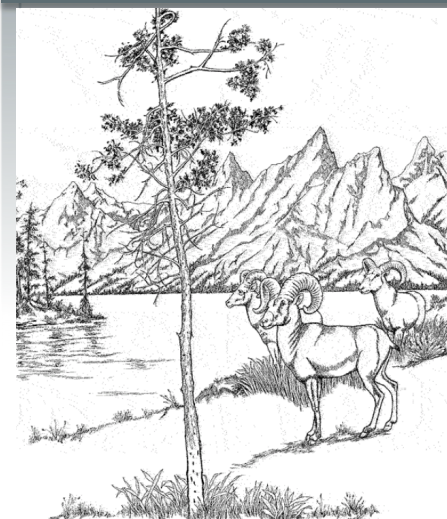
Grading Scale

Attendance

Homework Policy

As has been noted, **Practice Makes Permanent.** Therefore, it is very important that homework be done consistently and correctly.

Math: We are using the text *Go Math* by Houghton Mifflin. Homework will be sent home in a weekly packet or every day except for test days. Math homework is due the following day.

Reading: 30 minutes of reading outside of school is highly recommended for optimum growth. *Wonders* is the texts we use in fourth grade.

Spelling/Vocabulary: Words will be sent home on Monday. Assessments are generally on Friday.

Social Studies: We will be studying about our great state, Utah! Our text is Utah, Our Home.

Science: We follow *Utah State Core Academy* for our six science units. There will be a test at the completion of each unit.

Other homework assignments will be given throughout the year such as writing assignments, projects, etc. Students will be given all the information they need to receive 100% on these various assignments.
